- Case Management Services

(Based on need and availability of funding)

- Income Support Services
- Assistance Obtaining Benefits/Services (as eligible)
- Other Services/Referrals Necessary for Housing Stabilization

Who is Eligible?

- Head of household or spouse of head of household must have veteran status.
- Low income (Please call for income eligibility and requirements).
- If household is residing in permanent housing, must have a valid lease, eviction or 3 day notice
- Currently homeless or recently exited permanent housing within previous 90 days and scheduled/desire to become a resident of permanent housing within 90 days.

Required Documentation:

- Poof of veteran status (DD-214 Form-we can assist in obtaining)
- Proof of income (bank statements, pay stubs, DPSS print out, EDD printout)
- Copy of ID and Social Security Cards for all adults in household
- Copy of birth certificate for all children in household
- Other documentation as required
